

RECEIVE THE MIRACLE MY BETTER HALF

Who hasn't dreamed of finding their 'better half'? Someone who comes along and solves everything! Someone who comes along and fits perfectly with you... but what would that other half need to be like if you are still capable of fear? If you are still capable of hate? Only a 'perfect' half would fit an 'imperfect' half for the long-dreamed-of balance. This is the goal that the ego sets for all relationships... not just romantic ones. It is the role of the other (people, things or objects) to give us what we believe we lack. It is the role of the other to give us perfection for what we judge to be imperfect.

And thus does he become your victim, not your brother, different from you in that he is more guilty, thus in need of your correction, as the one more innocent than he (T-7.II.11:4).

We are capable of fear and therefore perceive ourselves as innocent. After all, how could we not be, if fear and even anger seem totally justified, since the other always sins? Since the other fails and, at some point, will show us only imperfection... since the other will never be perfect enough that you no longer need to remember who you are?

Doesn't this system of thinking, where one half lives in opposition to the other, seem like a trick of the ego? Doesn't it seem like a ploy to keep us distracted in time, in an endless (external) search?

The only Master tells you, as long as time lasts: 'You are not a part, because we are already One.' And in that impeccably holy Instant is the Certainty that we lack nothing. That the other is not the symbol of our fear. He is the bearer of the Remembrance of Who we are. He does not sin, because we are all impeccable. He is the one who mirrors us so that we may see the One Image, That in the Likeness of our Father, the Image of Christ.

He is among us. Word of Salvation... Grace be to God! Christ is among us because He lives in each one of us. And the Word of Salvation could not be anything other than the Grace of God. And the Grace of God is the Answer to the Memory of Unity. And the Answer is the Holy Spirit.

Receive God's Grace, so that He may occupy that place that seems empty to you. The Mission of the Holy Spirit is to remind us that this feeling of emptiness is only the reflection of a mistaken practice. Free yourself. Choose a new practice — one that integrates your Mind, until Christ reveals Himself fully.

A THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK THE WATERS OF NOAH

When you feel overwhelmed by a flood, enter your ark. The hellish waves that sweep everything away and cause such destruction are the thoughts held by a mind that believes it is separate from God. Remember that these waves are, in essence, peaceful waters. Remember that there is no possibility of anything being outside of God. Do as Noah did... build your ark. Practise the 'observing self.' When the waves do not seem loving, direct the power of your observation towards yourself. Instead of drowning, allow the waters to carry you to the only place where we truly are... a serene place that we would not otherwise reach.



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
