

RECEIVE THE MIRACLE WILL OF STEEL

MIRACLE AT ONE SOMETHING'S GOTTA GIVE

How about 70% Truth, 30% illusion, and everyone 'leaves' happy? Can't we try to reconcile the irreconcilable? Yes, we can. We can so much that we do. The percentage in this agreement to coexist with the ego varies greatly, but the question is: how do we decide on this compromise if Truth is one, total and indivisible?

Sustained by God's Love, we find it difficult to choose between Miracles and beliefs and, thus, by mistake, we try the 'middle ground'. Every mistake is a concession we give to the ego. Truth does not compromise because It is Love. Only Love, and nothing else. And if we still believe in a single illusion, we are still committed to error: 'it's okay, just one illusion is acceptable.' Acceptable to whom? Who is the one who accepts just one little illusion? And if there are still those who accept only one illusion, Who is the One Who has to give in?

He will not yield. There is no compromise possible between fear and Love, between guilt and Innocence, between illusion and Truth. And thanks to His intransigence, which is our only place of safety, we are free and can even dream of all this impossibility. Thanks to eternal, complete and totally shared Love, it is impossible for Creation to suffer any effect of this flexibility. Thanks to our Father, we can, here and now, choose to stop dreaming and stop giving in to the ego, emerging from the illusion of what we believe ourselves to be into the acceptance of Who we truly are... without any percentage break, exactly as God created us.



A THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK DARKNESS IS NOT ETERNAL

Light is our home and our destiny. Even if we are mistaken about what is true or distracted and identified with darkness, Light is eternal.
