

NOW, WE BEGIN

What do you believe needs to continue existing? The sun? Your family? Your bank account? Breathe calmly. Now, tell me... what do you believe needs to exist from one moment to the next? The Sun? Joy? Abundance?

What would be the Reason for things, people, and events to exist, if not the Will of our Creator? Nothing exists out of necessity. There is no reason for something to continue to exist from one moment to the next, except by the Will of God.

Today does not exist because yesterday existed. Today is a creation in itself. Here and now, we are in a totally new moment, including in it the past and future of that moment. Nothing predicts it. Nothing emerges from 'yesterday.' 'Today' is totally new, an unprecedented phenomenon. An idea entirely separate from our frame of reference.

Isn't true creativity also unprecedented? Who could create something absolutely new? My bet would be: an unprecedented creator... without references, without necessity, without form, without pattern. Perhaps... an expression of free will? Of freedom?

And how do we truly create, free from the frame of reference that accompanies us 'wherever we go'? Truth, Beginning, Freedom... these three words reveal 'details' of God's Will extended eternally in each one of us. And as we practise remembering how to 'operate in such a way,' inevitably every moment becomes a gift. And in that gift, we change the direction of the now and, with it, the direction of the past and the future.

Truth is in the now, Beginning is in us, and Freedom... will always be in our desire, that is, where we always start.

EXERCISE

I propose you - think about the word REASON. What does it still mean to you? For me, reason is certainty. The one I believe I have in front of people, events and things. 'I am right.' And if I am right, then someone, in this very moment, is not—least of all God.

But what if we think about Divine Reason? What would that be? It is also Certainty. But not mine, God's. And if it is God's, it cannot be fragmented, special to one or the other, nor does it depend on space or time. God's Certainty is this: We are One. And the Reason that gives Him this Certainty is the Purpose of Creation.

So... observe a recurring thought — a problem, an expectation, a feeling of resistance. Do not seek to be right. Just observe. Truly desire that God's Reason replace yours so that the Only Purpose may be fulfilled here and now.
